1.6.4	Not less than 12 months approved seagoing service on ships of greater than 750kW engine power whilst holding a Certificate of Competency as an Engine Watchkeeping Rating and completed not less than 6 months of approved work shop training; or		
1.6.5	Not less than 6 months approved workshop whilst holding a Certificate of Competency as Able seafarer Engine served on duties associated with engine operation.
