

406 MHz EPIRB Registration (Fiji coded beacons only)

This form is to be used for registering 406 MHz EPIRBs that are coded with the Fiji country code and shall serve as a record of all EPIRBs installed on Fiji registered Ships. The owner shall accurately complete this form. The completed form will aid the Authority in maintaining a current EPIRB Register for Search and Rescue (SAR) purposes.

Registration is FREE.

If you have a beacon coded with a foreign country code, or if you do not know what country, code has been used, please check online at www.cospas-sarsat.org/beacondecode

Information contained in this form is critical to your safety and to successful SAR response.

When entering information, you must include details in the following sections:

- Reason for registration;
- EPIRB details;
- Use of Beacon;
- Owner/Operator details;
- Supplier details;
- Alternative 24 Hour Emergency Contacts; and
- Ship details.
